- The circle of yellow represents the sun. The sun is the giver of life, the giver of hope, and the anchor that guides us wherever we go.
- The feathers are those of the lyrebird, the traditional totem of the Dharawal people. These feathers are an enduring symbol of the importance of the area, and connects the business back to Nathan's traditional land.


